

## **Pharaoh Hound Club of America Breed Mentor Agreement**

The parent club's responsibility to educate those who seek information and knowledge on their breed from a qualified teacher/mentor is a venture not to be regarded lightly. In the interest of a cohesive and impartial educational program, an agreement between the parent club known as the Pharaoh Hound Club of America (PHCA) and the participating club members listed as parent club approved mentors of this organization is as follows and agreed upon:

- 1) The mentor is to be a parent club (PHCA) member who is in good standing and has been involved with the Pharaoh Hound breed for a minimum of twelve 12 years.
- 2) The mentor is to adhere to all club rules and PHCA Code of Ethics set forth by the parent club in all areas of conduct and breeding practices, having demonstrated the ability to be a positive and productive ambassador of the breed.
- 3) The mentor must be knowledgeable and respectful of the current AKC approved breed standard at all times.
- 4) All mentoring sessions shall be conducted in a fair and impartial manner with restraint from promoting individual breeding programs and/or promotion of individual dogs and without bias towards other breeding programs.
- 5) It is understood that various styles exist in the breed and, while it would be appropriate to discuss these variations, they must be presented in an unbiased and educational manner only.
- 6) Mentors are to provide dogs for educational programs and workshops when requested and available.
- 7) The mentor is to demonstrate a willingness to present club-approved programs and workshops when requested available.
- 8) The mentor is to participate and attend a scheduled National Specialty mentor meeting, if offered, at least once every three (3) years to maintain parent club approved mentor status.
- 9) The mentor is to participate in National Specialty Judge's Education formal mentoring ringside sessions and workshops, when available, requested, and approved.
- 10) Failure to comply with this agreement, as well as the Breed Mentor Application Criteria and Breed Mentor Conduct Requirements, could result in removal from the mentoring program.
